Call to Order

Nancy Tiseo called the Board of Canvassers meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.

Approval of Minutes – August 5, 2025 Election Canvass

Canvass of November 4, 2025 Election Results

The Board began the canvass of the election and canvassed without incident, temporarily adjourning from day to day. MOVE and AV Cure ballots were processed from Richmond City, Washington Twp, St. Clair Shores, New Baltimore, Warren, and Sterling Heights on November 12th. On November 12th at 2:30 p.m., a motion was made by Alysa Diebolt and seconded by Joyce Aragona to accept the canvassed results and certify all races excluding Richmond Schools and Romeo Schools; the motion passed unanimously. The meeting was temporarily adjourned until the call of the Chair, awaiting out of county results.
